

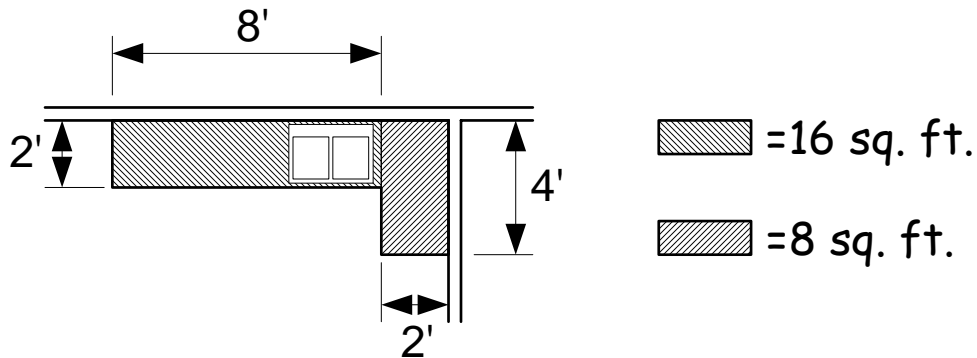

How to Measure Your Countertop

Before ordering your Complete Granite Countertop Tiling System by Bedrock Creations, there are a few measurements that you will need to take in order to calculate how many of each component you will need. Use the following directions to help ensure the quantities you order are correct.

1) How many 12x12 field tiles do I need?

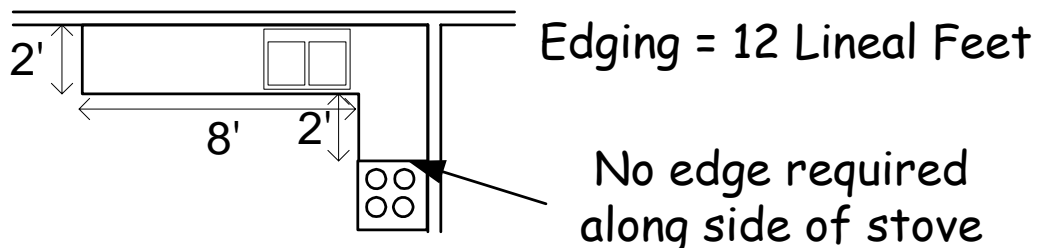
Start by measuring your counter depth and multiply by the counter length. When measuring an 'L' shaped counter, you need to make sure you don't add the corner of the 'L' twice. (see below)



Repeat these steps on all the surfaces that need field tiles and add the amounts together. It is advised to add a few extra pieces, just in case a cut doesn't turn out quite right. Extra pieces can also be helpful with color blending when you are dry fitting the tiles.

2) How many 2x12 edge rails do I need?

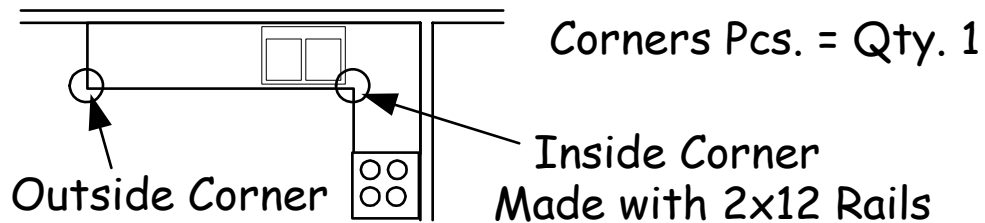
Measure the total length of edging along the fronts and sides of your countertop. If you have an appliance that butts up against the side of the countertop and cabinet below, you would not require 2x12 edge rails along that edge.



Repeat these steps on all surfaces that require edge rail and add the amounts together. Again, it is advised to add a few extra pieces, just in case a cut doesn't turn out quite right.

3) How many 2x2 outside corners do I need?

The 2x2 corner is only used where you have a 90o corner condition. If you are creating a corner that is other than 90o, you do this by mitering the edge rails to the correct angles. Inside corners are also created by mitering edge rails.
